## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Sgt. Marc Andrew McIntyre; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law  
3 enforcement officers with the untimely passing of Sgt. Marc Andrew McIntyre on December  
4 29, 2023; and

5 WHEREAS, Sgt. Marc Andrew McIntyre was born on Staten Island, New York, on  
6 December 6, 1968, a beloved son of Henry McIntyre and Janis O'Connor McIntyre; and

7 WHEREAS, Sgt. McIntyre was highly regarded by the citizens of his community and state  
8 and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the  
9 sound principles of law enforcement; and

10 WHEREAS, he served with honor and distinction as a member of the Spalding County  
11 Sheriff's Office and S.W.A.T. team, and his life was tragically taken in the line of duty while  
12 he heroically carried out the difficult responsibilities of his vocation; and

13 WHEREAS, Sgt. McIntyre exhibited extraordinary devotion to public service, outstanding  
14 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties; and

15 WHEREAS, he will long be remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of  
16 others, which stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement  
17 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Sgt. Marc Andrew  
20 McIntyre and express their most sincere condolences at his passing.
