A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and honoring May, 2019, as Asian-Pacific American Heritage Month and as an
- 2 important time to celebrate the significant contributions of Asian Americans and Pacific
- 3 Islanders to the history of the United States; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the people of the United States join together each May to pay tribute to the
- 5 contributions of generations of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders who have enriched the
- 6 history of the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the history of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in the United States is
- 8 inextricably tied to the story of the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Asian American and Pacific Islander community is a diverse population,
- 10 comprising more than 45 distinct ethnicities, with more than 100 dialects; and
- 11 WHEREAS, according to the Bureau of the Census, the Asian American population grew
- 12 at a faster rate than any other racial or ethnic group in the United States during the last
- decade, surging nearly 46 percent between 2000 and 2010—a growth rate four times greater
- 14 than that of the total population of the United States; and
- 15 WHEREAS, according to the 2010 decennial census, in the United States, there are
- approximately 17.3 million residents who identify themselves as Asian and approximately
- 17 1.2 million residents who identify themselves as Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander,
- making up approximately 5.5 percent and 0.4 percent, respectively, of the total population
- 19 of the United States; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the month of May was selected for Asian-Pacific American Heritage Month
- 21 because the first immigrants from Japan arrived in the United States on May 7, 1843, and the
- 22 first transcontinental railroad was completed on May 10, 1869, with substantial contributions
- 23 from immigrants from China; and

24 WHEREAS, Section 102 of Title 36, United States Code, officially designates May as

- 25 Asian-Pacific American Heritage Month and requests that the President issue an annual
- 26 proclamation calling on the people of the United States to observe Asian-Pacific American
- 27 Heritage Month with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders have made significant contributions in
- 29 both the government and armed forces of the United States; and
- 30 WHEREAS, in 2019, Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders are serving in state and
- 31 territorial legislatures across the United States in record numbers, including in the states of
- 32 Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Maryland,
- 33 Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North
- 34 Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia,
- 35 Washington, and West Virginia, and the territories of American Samoa, Guam, and the
- 36 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and
- 37 WHEREAS, the number of federal judges who are Asian Americans or Pacific Islanders
- doubled between 2001 and 2008 and more than tripled between 2009 and 2016, reflecting
- 39 a commitment to diversity in the federal judiciary that has resulted in the confirmation of
- 40 high-caliber Asian American and Pacific Islander judicial nominees; and
- 41 WHEREAS, there remains much to be done to ensure that Asian Americans and Pacific
- 42 Islanders have access to resources and a voice in the government of the United States and
- 43 continue to advance in the political landscape of the United States; and
- 44 WHEREAS, Asian-Pacific American Heritage Month is an important time to celebrate the
- 45 significant contributions of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders to the history of the
- 46 United States and recognize that the Asian American and Pacific Islander community
- 47 strengthens and enhances the rich diversity of the United States.
- 48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 49 the members of this body recognize and honor May, 2019, as Asian-Pacific American
- 50 Heritage Month.
- 51 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 52 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 53 public and the press.
