3 Southeast Bulloch High School in 1956; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Janelle, on June 10, 1960, and
5 they were blessed with two remarkable children, Mike and Angie; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Raybon is a long-time member of Statesboro
7 Primitive Baptist Church, and it has been said that he is a genuine man of integrity who has
8 always put God in the center of everything he has done and that he is a leader and problem
9 solver with a servant's heart; and
