- 2 Month at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, peanuts and peanut products are recognized throughout our nation and the
- 4 world as an appetizing and nutritious food, providing protein and other nutrients as part of
- 5 a well-balanced diet; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia leads the United States in peanut production, producing
- 7 approximately 52 percent of the total supply in the nation in 2022; our state leads the nation
- 8 in peanut exports, supplying nearly half of the United States peanut exports and contributing
- 9 more than \$320 million toward our nation's balance of trade; and
- 10 WHEREAS, peanut production is the largest single cash food row crop in Georgia with gross
- 11 farm receipts totaling hundreds of millions of dollars; and
- 12 WHEREAS, more than 250 Georgia companies engaged in warehousing, processing,
- manufacturing, and marketing totally depend on the peanut industry, and hundreds of other
- 14 Georgia companies that engage in financing, supplying, distributing, and transporting are
- 15 dependent to some extent on the peanut industry; and
