- 7 WHEREAS, he was also awarded the Bronze Star for his heroic action of holding off enemy
- 8 attack while his patrol escaped to safety; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dr. Poston was awarded the Purple Heart, given for valor and dedication in the
- 10 line of duty, which is one of the most honored awards in all branches of the United States
- military and given only to those who are wounded or killed in the service of our country; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he formed and maintained the Vietnam Veterans of Bartow County, Georgia,
- an organization which has served the veterans of Bartow County in multiple ways; and
- 14 WHEREAS, having earned a master's degree in human behavior from the University of
- 15 Oklahoma and a doctorate in psychology from the University of New Mexico, Dr. Poston
- 16 now serves the community by counseling and mentoring countless veterans and citizens
- 17 within Bartow County so they can receive the help and support they need; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Poston leads the local chapter of the National Alliance on Mental Illness
- 19 (NAMI), known as The Phoenix Project, which is a faith based organization that provides
- 20 skills for living and support groups for mental health services, anger management, domestic
- 21 violence, substance abuse treatment, probation services, Bartow County PTSD Vet to Vet,
- 22 and jail diversion; and
