3 with the passing of Rudolph Bullard on May 9, 2021; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Rudolph Bullard was born on July 24, 1941, in Varnville, South Carolina; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
6 States Air Force, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the
7 Vietnam War; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Rudolph Bullard was an active member of
9 First Baptist Church of Griffin; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Rudolph Bullard worked at Delta Airlines as an aircraft mechanic for over 30
11 years, and he was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting, working in his garden, and
12 spending time with his grandchildren; and

13 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
14 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
15 family and friends were admired by others; and

16 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
17 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
18 made this world a better place in which to live; and

19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Rudolph Bullard will long be remembered
20 for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
21 fortune of knowing him.
