12 administrator working with organizations who serve the most vulnerable; and

13 WHEREAS, Keisha has written and managed more than \$54 million in grants and contracts
14 for government, local, and national nonprofits to support local communities; and

15 WHEREAS, she enjoys working with several charitable organizations in the local
16 community who are committed to serving youth and homeless individuals to place them on
17 a path toward success and long-term stability; and

18 WHEREAS, Keisha has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout Georgia for
19 her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body congratulate and commend Keisha Jones for receiving the 2022
24 Yellow Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award and extend best wishes for her
