- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Nora Wood Goodman; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Nora Wood Goodman on January 9, 2024; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Nora Wood Goodman was born on April 20, 1940, in Madison, Georgia, a
5 beloved daughter of Henry and Estelle Wood; and
- 6 WHEREAS, she served as the Georgia Farm Bureau (GFB) 3rd District director and as the
7 Paulding County Farm Bureau president, dedicating innumerable hours of her time and
8 energy to agricultural development and her community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, during her 45 years as a Georgia Farm Bureau member, she contributed
10 significantly to the farming community and served on various GFB Commodity Advisory
11 Committees as a representative of the GFB Board of Directors; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in addition to her farm bureau leadership, she was an active member of the
13 Georgia Cattlemen's Association, a director of the Georgia Agriculture Land Trust, and a
14 member of the Tri-County Cattlemen's Association; and

15 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Dr. Jim Goodman, and was
16 blessed with a wonderful son, John Achter; and

17 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
18 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
19 her family and friends were admired by others; and

20 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
22 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Nora Wood Goodman will long be
24 remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
25 had the great fortune of knowing her.
