A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing concern regarding organ harvesting in the People's Republic of China; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, there continue to be persistent and credible reports of systematic, state
- 4 sanctioned organ harvesting from nonconsenting prisoners of conscience and members of
- 5 religious and ethnic minority groups in the People's Republic of China, resulting in mass
- 6 killings of Uyghurs, Tibetans, select Christians, and practitioners of Falun Gong in order to
- 7 obtain organs for transplants; and
- 8 WHEREAS, China's organ transplantation system does not comply with the World Health
- 9 Organization's guiding principles of traceability and transparency in organ procurement, and
- 10 China's government has resisted independent scrutiny of their system; and
- 11 WHEREAS, new investigative reports conclude that the Chinese Communist Party has
- 12 engaged in the mass killings of innocent people to obtain organs for transplants, and China's
- official figure of 10,000 transplants each year has been understated by an order of magnitude;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, in July, 1999, the Chinese Communist Party launched an intensive, nation-wide
- 16 persecution of the popular, spiritual practice of Falun Gong, which is centered on the values
- of truthfulness, compassion, and forbearance, extralegally detaining hundreds of thousands
- 18 of practitioners in Chinese reeducation-through-labor camps, detention centers, and prisons
- 19 where torture, abuse, and implausible medical exams and blood tests are routine; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the United Nations Committee Against Torture and the Special Rapporteur on
- 21 Torture have expressed concerns over allegations of organ harvesting from Falun Gong
- 22 prisoners and have called on China's government to increase accountability and transparency
- 23 in their organ transplantation system and to punish those responsible for abuses; and

24 WHEREAS, the government of China is hereby called upon to end immediately the

- 25 harvesting of organs from all prisoners, and explicitly from Falun Gong prisoners of
- 26 conscience and members of religious and ethnic minority groups, as this practice is an
- 27 egregious and intolerable violation of the fundamental right to live; and
- 28 WHEREAS, organ tourism to China should not be shielded by medical confidentiality but
- 29 openly monitored, and no nation should allow its citizens to go to China for transplants until
- 30 China has allowed a full investigation into organ harvesting of past and present prisoners of
- 31 conscience; and
- 32 WHEREAS, the medical community in the State of Georgia is encouraged to educate our
- 33 citizens about the risks of traveling to China for organ transplants so as to prevent them from
- 34 unwittingly becoming involved in murder in the form of forced organ harvesting from
- 35 prisoners of conscience.
- 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 37 the members of this body urge the People's Republic of China to end the unethical practice
- 38 of forced harvesting of organs from prisoners, especially from Falun Gong and other
- 39 prisoners of conscience.
- 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 41 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 42 public and the press.
