- by the CDC as Lead Facilitator of the WILLOW intervention; and

- 29 WHEREAS, her work is featured in two documentaries titled *Silent Epidemic* and *Hidden*
- 30 Epidemic about the trans community and HIV in the south; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Tori Cooper's vision and unyielding commitment to the HIV and transgender
- 32 communities has set the standard in public health; and
- WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
