A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 6, 2020, as College Park Day at the state capitol; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mayor Bianca Motley Broom made history by becoming the first black female
4 mayor in the city's history; and

5 WHEREAS, the City of College Park, Georgia, serves as home to the headquarters of
6 thriving businesses such as ExpressJet Airlines and Chick-fil-A; and

7 WHEREAS, the city also serves as home to the fourth largest urban historical district
8 registered with the National Register of Historic Places in the State of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of College Park contains a portion of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta
10 International Airport, the world's busiest airport since 1998, including the domestic terminal,
11 Concourse T, Concourse A, and two-thirds of Concourse B; and

12 WHEREAS, the City of College Park welcomes millions of travelers to the great State of
13 Georgia every year, displaying the state's great hospitality and southern charm.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 the members of this body recognize February 6, 2020, as College Park Day at the state
16 capitol.
