BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article VII, Section II of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph II as follows:

"Paragraph II. *Exemptions from taxation of property.* (a) (1) Except as otherwise

provided in this Constitution, no property shall be exempted from ad valorem taxation

unless the exemption is approved by two-thirds of the members elected to each branch of

the General Assembly in a roll-call vote and by a majority of the qualified electors of the

state voting in a referendum thereon.

(2) Homestead and other exemptions from ad valorem taxation levied by local taxing

jurisdictions may be granted by local law conditioned upon approval by a majority of the

qualified electors residing within the limits of the local taxing jurisdiction voting in a

17 (3) Laws subject to the requirement of a referendum as provided in this subparagraph (a) may originate in either the Senate or the House of Representatives.

- (4) The requirements of this subparagraph (a) shall not apply with respect to a law which codifies or recodifies an exemption previously authorized in the Constitution of 1976 or an exemption authorized pursuant to this Constitution.
- 22 (b) The grant of any exemption from ad valorem taxation shall be subject to the conditions, limitations, and administrative procedures specified by law."

- 25 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 26 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 27 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 28 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize exemptions
- 29 () NO from local ad valorem taxation in addition to homestead exemptions which are already authorized?"
- 31 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 32 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 33 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 34 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
