## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending "Able" Mable Thomas; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, "Able" Mable Thomas is a former member of the Georgia House of
- 3 Representatives and was the youngest member when she first won election; and
- 4 WHEREAS, her political career began when she was chosen as a presidential delegate for
- 5 candidate Jesse Jackson at the 1984 Democratic National Convention; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in that same year, she won a seat in the Georgia House of Representatives,
- 7 where she served four terms; in 1997, she ran for and won a seat on the Atlanta City Council;
- 8 in 2000, she returned to the House where she served for six years; and in 2010, she returned
- 9 to the House and served until 2020; and
- WHEREAS, she is heavily involved with revitalization efforts in The Bluff neighborhoods
- 11 on Atlanta's westside; and
- 12 WHEREAS, she is known globally as a founding mother of the reproductive justice
- 13 movement; and

14 WHEREAS, the Black women who were the founding mothers of the reproductive justice

- 15 movement, involved in coining the term, and laying the initial framework were: "Able"
- 16 Mable Thomas, Toni M. Bond Leonard, Loretta Ross, Reverend Alma Crawford, Evelyn S.
- 17 Field, Terri James, Bisola Marignay, Cassandra McConnell, Cynthia Newbille, Elizabeth
- 18 Terry, Winnette P. Willis, and Kim Youngblood; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she made history when \$21 million was included in the state budget for
- 20 postpartum Medicaid coverage for one year with direct support from former Representative
- 21 Renitta Shannon; and
- 22 WHEREAS, she passed groundbreaking legislation to allow mammograms, prostate exams,
- 23 and pap smears to be covered as medical expenses; and
- 24 WHEREAS, she has received awards from many national organizations, including the Joe
- 25 Manns Black Wall Street Award in May, 2023, and has had awards named after her; and
- 26 WHEREAS, much of her legacy is carried out through the nonprofit organization named
- 27 Sistersong whose mission is to strengthen and amplify the collective voices of women of
- 28 color to achieve reproductive justice by eradicating reproductive oppression and securing
- 29 human rights.
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 31 the members of this body recognize and commend "Able" Mable Thomas and thank her for
- 32 her efforts of behalf of her community and state.
