- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law
3 enforcement officers with the untimely passing of Officer Scott Riner on December 13, 2022;

- 5 WHEREAS, Officer Riner was highly regarded by the citizens of his community and state
6 and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the
7 sound principles of law enforcement; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he served with honor and distinction as a correctional officer in Gwinnett
9 County, Georgia, and his life was tragically taken in the line of duty while he heroically
10 carried out the difficult responsibilities of his vocation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Officer Riner exhibited extraordinary devotion to public service, outstanding
12 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties; and

13 WHEREAS, he will long be remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of
14 others, which stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement
15 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Officer Scott Riner and
18 express their most sincere condolences at his passing.
