

Senate Bill 100

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state government,  
2 so as to provide that no person possessing a valid visa to enter the United States shall be  
3 detained or rejected from entry into the United States at any airport or water port in this state;  
4 to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state government, is amended  
9 by adding a new chapter to read as follows:

10 "CHAPTER 39

11 50-39-1.

12 No person possessing a valid visa to enter the United States shall be detained or rejected  
13 from entry into the United States at any airport or water port in this state."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
16 without such approval.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
