A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions relative to state government, so as to provide that this state shall observe
3 standard time year round until such time as Congress authorizes the states to observe daylight
4 savings time; to provide for contingent effectiveness; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
9 provisions relative to state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
10 follows:

11 "50-1-10.

12 (a) Except as provided for in subsection (b) of this Code section, this state, including all
13 political subdivisions thereof, shall observe standard time year round as the standard time
14 of the entire state and all of its political subdivisions.

15 (b) If the United States Congress amends 15 U.S.C. Section 260a to authorize states to
16 observe daylight savings time year round, at such time this state, including all of its

17 political subdivisions thereof, shall observe daylight savings time year round as the
18 standard time of the entire state and all of its political subdivisions."

SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
