A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 43-34-283 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 licensure requirements for pain management clinics, so as to revise a provision relating to
- 3 the health care professionals who must be on-site at a pain management clinic in order for
- 4 the clinic to provide medical treatment or services; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 43-34-283 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to licensure
- 9 requirements for pain management clinics, is amended by revising subsection (g) as follows:
- 10 "(g) No controlled substance shall be prescribed or dispensed in a pain management clinic
- 11 nor shall a controlled substance prescription be distributed to a patient from a pain
- management clinic shall provide medical treatment or services, as defined by the board,
- unless a physician, a physician assistant authorized to prescribe controlled substances under
- an approved job description, or an advanced practice registered nurse authorized to
- prescribe controlled substances pursuant to a physician protocol is on-site at the pain
- management clinic. <u>For purposes of this article, dispensing shall not include the</u>
- 17 <u>administration of anesthesia by a certified registered nurse anesthetist practicing pursuant</u>
- 18 <u>to Code Section 43-26-11.1."</u>

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
