A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to professions and businesses, so as to revise the grounds for
- 3 refusing to grant or revoking a license; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
- 4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions relative to professions and businesses, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of
- 9 subsection (q) of Code Section 43-1-19, relating to grounds for refusing to grant or revoking
- 10 licenses, application of Administrative Procedure Act, subpoena powers, disciplinary actions,
- 11 judicial review, reinstatement, investigations, complaints, surrender, and probationary
- 12 license, as follows:

- 13 "(q)(1) Notwithstanding paragraphs (3) and (4) of subsection (a) of this Code section or
- any other provision of law, and unless a felony or crime involving moral turpitude
- directly relates to the occupation for which the license is sought or held, no professional
- licensing board shall refuse to grant a license to an applicant therefor or shall revoke the

license of an individual licensed by that board due solely or in part to such applicant's or

- 18 licensee's:
- 19 (A) Conviction of any felony or any crime involving moral turpitude, whether it
- 20 occurred in the courts of this state or any other state, territory, or country or in the
- courts of the United States;
- 22 (B) Arrest, charge, and sentence for the commission of such offense;
- 23 (C) Sentence for such offense pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 42 or another
- state's first offender laws;
- 25 (D) Sentence for such offense pursuant to subsection (a) or (c) of Code
- 26 Section 16-13-2;
- 27 (E) Sentence for such offense as a result of a plea of nolo contendere; or
- 28 (F) Adjudication of guilt or sentence was otherwise withheld or not entered; or
- 29 (G) Being under supervision by a community supervision officer, as such term is
- defined in Code Section 42-3-1, for a conviction of any felony or any crime involving
- moral turpitude, whether it occurred in the courts of this state or any other state,
- territory, or country or in the courts of the United States, so long as such individual was
- not convicted of a felony violation of Chapter 5 of Title 16 nor convicted of a crime
- 34 <u>requiring registration on the state sexual offender registry."</u>

35 SECTION 2.

- 36 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 37 without such approval.

38 SECTION 3.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
