The House Committee on Rules offers the following substitute to SB 115:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 44-8-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to rights of adjoining landowners in navigable streams, so as to provide for intent, title to, and public use of navigable waters; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

Code Section 44-8-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to rights of adjoining landowners in navigable streams, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

"(c) The General Assembly finds that the state procured ownership of all navigable stream beds within its jurisdiction upon statehood and, as sovereign, is trustee of its peoples' rights to use and enjoy all navigable streams capable of use for fishing, hunting, passage, navigation, commerce, and transportation, pursuant to the common law public trust doctrine. The state continues to hold title to all such stream beds, except where title in a private party originates from a valid Crown or state grant before 1863. The General
