## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to HOPE scholarships and grants, so as to provide that the amount of a
- 3 HOPE scholarship shall be accepted as full payment of tuition by University System of
- 4 Georgia institutions; to provide that the amount of a HOPE grant shall be accepted as full
- 5 payment of tuition by institutions of the Technical College System of Georgia; to provide for
- 6 related matters; to provide for a contingent effective date and contingent repeal; to repeal
- 7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 11 relating to HOPE scholarships and grants, is amended by repealing in their entirety
- paragraphs (26.1) and (27) of Code Section 20-3-519, relating to definitions regarding HOPE
- 13 scholarships and grants.

14 SECTION 2.

- 15 Said part is further amended by revising subsection (e) and repealing subsection (f) of Code
- 16 Section 20-3-519.2, relating to eligibility requirements for a HOPE scholarship, as follows:
- 17 "(e) Subject to the amounts appropriated by the General Assembly and provisions relating
- 18 to the Lottery for Education Account in Code Section 50-27-13, a HOPE scholarship
- awarded under this Code section shall be equal to the HOPE award amount. <u>Such HOPE</u>
- 20 <u>scholarship award shall be accepted by all institutions of the University System of Georgia</u>
- 21 as full payment for tuition for the courses taken by a qualifying student at any such
- 22 <u>institution during such fiscal year, and such student shall not be charged any additional</u>
- 23 amount for tuition for such courses."

SECTION 3.

- 25 Said part is further amended by revising subsection (d) and repealing subsection (d.1) of
- 26 Code Section 20-3-519.5, relating to eligibility requirements for a HOPE grant at a branch
- 27 of the Technical College System of Georgia, as follows:
- 28 "(d) Subject to the amounts appropriated by the General Assembly and provisions relating
- 29 to the Lottery for Education Account in Code Section 50-27-13, a HOPE grant awarded
- under this Code section shall equal the HOPE award amount. Such grants shall be
- 31 <u>accepted by all institutions of the Technical College System of Georgia as full payment for</u>
- 32 <u>tuition for the courses taken by a qualifying student at any such institution during such</u>
- fiscal year, and such student shall not be charged any additional amount for tuition for such
- 34 courses."

SECTION 4.

- 36 Said part is further amended by revising Code Section 20-3-519.10, relating to application
- 37 of HOPE scholarship and HOPE grant, as follows:
- 38 "20-3-519.10.
- 39 A Neither a HOPE scholarship and nor a HOPE grant may be applied to any portion of a
- 40 student's tuition. In no case shall a HOPE scholarship or HOPE grant exceed a student's
- 41 tuition."

42 SECTION 5.

- 43 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2017, provided that an amendment to the State
- 44 Constitution is passed by the General Assembly and ratified by the electors at the November,
- 45 2015, general election authorizing the General Assembly by general law to establish the
- 46 amount of tuition that may be charged to students receiving lottery funded scholarships and
- 47 grants and attending colleges and universities operated by the Board of Regents of the
- 48 University System of Georgia or institutions operated by the Technical College System of
- 49 Georgia. Otherwise, this Act shall be repealed by operation of law on January 1, 2017.

50 **SECTION 6.** 

51 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
