A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 2 flag, seal, and other symbols, so as to provide for placement of a monument in honor of the
- 3 Honorable Zell Bryan Miller upon the capitol grounds of the state capitol building; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state flag, seal,
- 8 and other symbols, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

9 "ARTICLE 7

- 10 50-3-120.
- 11 (a) Subject to the availability of funds, there shall be placed within the capitol building or
- 12 grounds a monument honoring the memory and legacy of the Honorable Zell Bryan Miller.

13 (b)(1) Such monument shall be designed, procured, and placed by the Capitol Art

- 14 Standards Commission, subject to final approval by a monument committee composed
- of the following members of the General Assembly:
- 16 (A) Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the
- 17 <u>House of Representatives;</u>
- 18 (B) Two members of the Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and
- 19 (C) One member from each house of the General Assembly appointed by the
- Governor.
- 21 (2) The monument committee established pursuant to this subsection shall stand
- 22 <u>abolished upon placement of such monument.</u>
- 23 (c) No public funds shall be expended for the design or procurement of such monument.
- 24 Gifts and donations from private individuals, organizations, or foundations shall be
- 25 accepted and expended by the Capitol Art Standards Commission to carry out the
- 26 requirements of this Code section.
- 27 (d) Such monument shall be procured and placed as soon as practicable but not before the
- state has been granted any intellectual property license necessary for purposes of this Code
- 29 section."

30 **SECTION 2.**

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
