A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to designate September 11 of each year as "First Responders
- 3 Appreciation Day" in Georgia; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 8 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 10 (a) September 11 of each year is designated as 'First Responders Appreciation Day' in
- 11 <u>Georgia.</u>
- 12 (b) Officials and departments of the state, educational institutions, members of the
- media, and all citizens of Georgia are encouraged to participate in programs, displays,
- and activities that show appreciation to Georgia's first responders and the sacrifice they
- make in the service of their communities."
