A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions regarding the regulation of alcoholic beverages, so as to provide that a person who has all necessary licenses to sell alcoholic beverages by the drink or for consumption on the premises may purchase malt beverages, wine, and distilled spirits from retailers under certain conditions for resale; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT EN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 10 general provisions regarding the regulation of alcoholic beverages, is amended by adding a
- 11 new Code section to read as follows:

13 Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, a person who has all

14 <u>necessary licenses to sell alcoholic beverages by the drink or for consumption on the</u>

15 premises may purchase malt beverages, wine, and distilled spirits from retailers within the

- 16 <u>same licensing jurisdiction as such person for the purpose of resale, provided that the</u>
- 17 purchase be made at retail with all applicable taxes being paid to the retailer and that all
- 18 applicable taxes be paid when such beverage is sold by the person by the drink or for
- 19 <u>consumption on the premises.</u>"

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
