A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 lottery for education, so as to provide a short title; to provide that the Georgia Lottery
- 3 Corporation shall offer one or more games to benefit veterans; to provide for the deposit of
- 4 proceeds into the general fund; to provide for a special account to be appropriated for
- 5 veterans' programs; to provide for purposes for which appropriations shall be made; to
- 6 provide for lapsing of funds; to provide a conditional effective date and automatic repeal; to
- 7 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to lottery for
- education, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:
- 12 "ARTICLE 4
- 13 <u>50-27-120.</u>
- 14 This article shall be known and may be cited as the 'Georgia Lottery for Veterans.'
- 15 <u>50-27-121.</u>
- 16 The corporation shall offer one or more special instant scratch-off games for the benefit of
- 17 Georgia veterans. The game shall commence on January 1, 2017, or as soon thereafter as
- is reasonably practical. The operation of the game shall be governed by Article 1 of this
- chapter. If any provision of this article is inconsistent with any other provision of this
- 20 <u>chapter, then this article shall govern.</u>

- 22 On or before the fifteenth day of each quarter, the corporation shall transfer to the general
- 23 <u>fund of the state treasury, for credit to the Lottery for Veterans Account for the preceding</u>
- 24 quarter, the amount of all net proceeds during the preceding quarter from the special instant
- 25 <u>scratch-off game for the benefit of Georgia veterans. The state treasurer shall separately</u>
- 26 <u>account for net proceeds by establishing and maintaining a Lottery for Veterans Account</u>
- within the state treasury.
- 28 <u>50-27-123.</u>
- 29 <u>Upon their deposit into the state treasury, any moneys representing a deposit of net</u>
- 30 proceeds shall then become the unencumbered property of the State of Georgia and the
- 31 <u>corporation shall have no power to agree or undertake otherwise. Such moneys shall be</u>
- 32 <u>invested by the state treasurer in accordance with state investment practices. All earnings</u>
- 33 <u>attributable to such investments shall likewise be the unencumbered property of the state</u>
- and shall accrue to the credit of the Lottery for Veterans Account.

- 36 (a) In the budget report to the General Assembly, as a separate budget category entitled
- 37 <u>'lottery for veterans proceeds,' the Governor shall estimate the amount of net proceeds and</u>
- 38 <u>treasury earnings thereon to be credited to the Lottery for Veterans Account during the</u>
- 39 <u>fiscal year and the amount of unappropriated surplus estimated to be accrued in the account</u>
- 40 <u>at the beginning of the fiscal year. The sum of estimated net proceeds, treasury earnings</u>
- 41 <u>thereon, and unappropriated surplus shall be designated 'lottery for veterans proceeds.'</u>
- 42 (b) In the budget report, the Governor shall further make specific recommendations as to
- 43 <u>the programs and purposes for which appropriations should be made from the Lottery for</u>
- 44 <u>Veterans Account. The General Assembly shall appropriate from the Lottery for Veterans</u>
- 45 Account by specific reference to it, or by reference to 'lottery for veterans proceeds.' All
- 46 <u>appropriations of lottery for veterans proceeds to any particular budget unit shall be made</u>
- 47 <u>together in a separate part entitled, identified, administered, and accounted for separately</u>
- 48 <u>as a distinct budget unit for lottery for veterans proceeds. Such appropriations shall</u>
- 49 <u>otherwise be made in the manner required by law for appropriations. Such appropriations</u>
- shall be made for one or more of the following:
- 51 (1) Veterans' post traumatic stress disorder;
- 52 (2) Veterans' homelessness;
- 53 (3) The health insurance costs of veterans;
- 54 (4) Veterans' disability benefits, including, but not limited to, disability benefits provided
- by veterans service organizations and veterans assistance commissions or centers;

- 56 (5) The long-term care of veterans; and
- 57 (6) Veteran employment and employment training.
- 58 <u>50-27-125.</u>
- 59 Appropriations for veterans' programs from the account not committed during the fiscal
- 60 year shall lapse to the general fund and shall be credited to the Lottery for Veterans
- 61 Account.
- 62 <u>50-27-126.</u>
- 63 Except as provided by this article, appropriations from the Lottery for Veterans Account
- shall be subject to Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget Act.'"
- 65 SECTION 2.
- 66 This Act shall become effective only if an amendment to the Constitution of Georgia is
- 67 ratified at the time of the general election held in 2016 authorizing the expenditure of lottery
- 68 funds for the benefit of veterans' programs. Otherwise, this Act shall stand automatically
- 69 repealed on December 31, 2016.
- 70 SECTION 3.
- 71 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
