A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 49-4-159 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to Medicaid coverage for lactation and postpartum care, so as to require the Department of Community Health to allow mothers giving birth to retain Medicaid eligibility for one year following such birth; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 49-4-159 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to Medicaid 9 coverage for lactation and postpartum care, is amended as follows: "49-4-159. 10 11 (a) The department shall provide Medicaid coverage for: 12 (1) Lactation care and services, as defined in paragraph (5) of Code Section 43-22A-3, 13 to pregnant and lactating women and to children who are breastfeeding or receiving their 14 mother's milk; and 15 (2) Postpartum care for mothers for a period of six months one year following the date 16 the woman gives birth.

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- 17 (b) If necessary to implement the provisions of this Code section, the department shall
- 18 submit a Medicaid state plan amendment or waiver request to the United States Department
- 19 of Health and Human Services."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
