- 3 member of the General Assembly shall be declared vacant on the thirtieth day following such

- 6 for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 "<u>28-1-18.</u>
- 14 The seat of any member of the General Assembly shall be declared vacant on the thirtieth
- day following such member filing a statement of candidacy with the Federal Election
- 16 Commission declaring that such member is a candidate for a federal elective office,
- 17 provided that such member's seat shall not be vacated if the member terminates his or her
- 18 <u>candidacy and files appropriate notice of termination with the Federal Election</u>
- 19 <u>Commission prior to such thirtieth day."</u>
- 20 SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 22 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
