A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions relative to dogs, so as to provide that any domestic dog that is
- 3 registered with the American Kennel Club or United Kennel Club as a sporting breed group
- 4 dog, hound breed group dog, or nonsporting breed group dog or that is of a breed used in the
- 5 lawful pursuit of hunting in this state pursuant to Title 27, that is used during an established
- 6 hunting season to aid an individual to pursue or hunt wildlife, and whose owner or other
- 7 member of the household has a hunting permit from the Department of Natural Resources
- 8 shall be classified as a hunting dog, and the owner of any such dog shall receive the same
- 9 registration, licensing, or permitting fee from any local government as is available to owners
- 10 of dogs which have been spayed or neutered; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related
- 11 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

13 SECTION 1.

- 14 Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 15 general provisions relative to dogs, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 16 follows:

- 17 "<u>4-8-1.2.</u>
- 18 Any domestic dog that is registered with the American Kennel Club or United Kennel Club
- 19 <u>as a sporting breed group dog, hound breed group dog, or nonsporting breed group dog or</u>
- 20 that is of a breed used in the lawful pursuit of hunting in this state pursuant to Title 27, that
- 21 <u>is used during an established hunting season to aid an individual to pursue or hunt wildlife,</u>
- 22 and whose owner or other member of the household has a hunting permit from the
- 23 <u>Department of Natural Resources shall be classified as a hunting dog, and the owner of any</u>
- 24 <u>such dog shall receive the same registration, licensing, or permitting fee from any local</u>
- 25 government as is available to owners of dogs which have been spayed or neutered.
- Nothing in this Code section shall affect the ability of local governments to deal with
- 27 <u>vicious dogs, abandoned dogs, or stray dogs."</u>
