AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 elections and primaries generally, so as to revise the time for inputting credit for voting data;
3 to provide for sanctions for failure to meet deadlines; to provide for related matters; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
8 primaries generally, is amended by revising subsection (i) of Code Section 21-2-215, relating
9 to main office of board of registrars, location, business hours, additional registration places,
10 educators to serve as deputy registrars, training, and registration cards and papers, as follows:

11 "(i) The board of registrars shall enter into the state-wide voter registration system credit
12 for voting by qualified electors to the Secretary of State within ~~60~~ 30 days of a primary or
13 election for the purpose of maintaining the list of electors and voter history. For each day
14 beyond 30 days that the credit for voting data is not fully entered into the state-wide voter
15 registration system by a board of registrars, such board shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00
16 by the State Election Board."
