(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'psychotropic medication' means any drugshall not be dispensed or administered without a prescription whose primary indication use has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for treatment of mental disorders and that, as of January 1, 2017, is listed a psychotherapeutic agent in Drug Facts and Comparisons or in the American Hosp Formulary Service Drug Information. (b) Each local board of education shall be encouraged to adopt a policy that provinguidelines regarding students taking psychotropic medication or who have been reference for treatment of mental disorders.
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(c) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to create a prohibition against
school personnel from consulting or sharing classroom based observations with a pa
or guardian regarding a student's academic and functional performance, behavior, or n
