A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 5A of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Office of the State Treasurer, so as to require the state treasurer to collect certain data and
- 3 maintain and publish a data base that includes searchable information related to all
- 4 expenditures made by state entities to vendors; to require state entities to submit certain
- 5 information related to expenditures made to vendors; to require the state treasurer to provide
- 6 an opportunity for public comment and to publish annual usage statistics of such data base;
- 7 to authorize the state treasurer to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement
- 8 the foregoing provisions; to provide for definitions; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 9 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

11 SECTION 1.

- 12 Chapter 5A of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Office of
- 13 the State Treasurer, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 "50-5A-12.
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Data base' means the Expenditure Data Base of the State of Georgia.
- 17 (2) 'Expenditure' means a payment, distribution, loan, advance, reimbursement, deposit,
- or gift of money from a state entity to any vendor.
- 19 (3) 'State entity' means the General Assembly, the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals,
- 20 <u>the office of an elected state officer, or a department, bureau, board, office, commission,</u>
- 21 <u>agency</u>, institution, instrumentality, or other governmental entity of this state established
- by the Constitution or laws of this state for the exercise of any function of state
- 23 government, but not any county, municipality, local authority, local school district,
- 24 <u>institute of higher education, or retirement system as defined by Code Section 47-20-3.</u>

25 (4) 'Vendor' means any person, partnership, corporation, association, organization, state

- 26 <u>entity, or other party, including any executive officer, legislative officer, judicial officer,</u>
- or member or employee of a state entity, that does either of the following:
- 28 (A) Sells, leases, or otherwise provides equipment, materials, goods, supplies, or
- 29 <u>services to a state entity pursuant to a contract between the vendor and a state entity;</u>
- 30 <u>or</u>
- 31 (B) Receives reimbursement from a state entity for any expense.
- 32 (b)(1) The state treasurer shall establish and maintain a data base that shall be known as
- 33 <u>the 'Expenditure Data Base of the State of Georgia.' The data base shall contain all</u>
- 34 expenditures of state government made during each fiscal year that commences on or
- 35 <u>after July 1, 2017. Within six months of the close of each fiscal year, the data base shall</u>
- 36 <u>be made available on the website of the Office of the State Treasurer and accessible by</u>
- 37 members of the public for five years from the date of publication without charge.
- 38 (2) For each expenditure, the data base shall include the following information:
- 39 (A) The amount of the expenditure;
- 40 (B) The date the expenditure was paid;
- 41 (C) The vendor to which the expenditure was paid; and
- 42 (D) The state entity that made the expenditure or requested the expenditure be made.
- 43 (3) The data base shall be searchable and shall offer the ability to:
- 44 (A) Filter expenditures by the amount of the expenditure, the date the expenditure was
- paid, the vendor to which the expenditure was paid, and the state entity that made the
- 46 <u>expenditure or requested the expenditure be made;</u>
- 47 (B) Aggregate data contained in the data base;
- 48 (C) Determine the total amount of expenditures awarded to a vendor by a state entity;
- 49 <u>and</u>
- 50 (D) Download information obtained through the data base.
- 51 (c)(1) All state entities shall assist, as requested by the state treasurer and without cost,
- in the development, establishment, operation, storage, hosting, and support of the data
- 53 <u>base.</u>
- 54 (2) By the tenth day of each month, each state entity shall provide the information
- described in paragraph (2) of subsection (b) of this Code section to the state treasurer for
- 56 <u>each of the state entity's expenditures paid to a vendor for the preceding month.</u>
- 57 (3) Within 180 days of the initial publication of the data base, each state entity shall
- display and maintain thereafter an Internet link to the data base on its website.
- 59 (d) In addition to the data base, the state treasurer shall publish on the website of the Office
- of the State Treasurer graphical representations of data contained in the data base,
- 61 <u>including charts and graphs to assist comprehension of such data by the public. The topics</u>

illustrated by and frequency of developing and publishing these graphical representations
 shall be determined by the state treasurer.

- 64 (e)(1) Within one year of the initial publication of the data base, the state treasurer shall
- 65 provide an opportunity on the Office of State Treasurer's website for public comment on
- 66 <u>the utility of the data base.</u>
- 67 (2) On February 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, the state treasurer shall publish on its
- website statistics related to the usage of the data base during the prior calendar year.
- 69 (f) The data base shall not include any information that is confidential or not a public
- 70 record under the laws of this state; however, the state treasurer and the Office of the State
- 71 Treasurer and its employees are not liable for the inadvertent disclosure of a record
- 72 contained through the data base that is confidential or is not a public record under the laws
- of this state.
- 74 (g) The state treasurer shall be authorized to adopt rules and regulations necessary to
- 75 <u>implement this Code section.</u>"

76 SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
