A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 2-23-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 definitions regarding hemp farming, so as to revise a definition; to provide for related
3 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

6 Code Section 2-23-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
7 regarding hemp farming, is amended by revising paragraph (10) as follows:

8 "(10)(A) 'Process' or 'processing,' except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (B) of
9 this paragraph, means converting an agricultural commodity into a legally marketable
10 form.

11 (B) ~~This~~ Such term does not include:

12 (i) ~~merely~~ Merely placing raw or dried material into another container or packaging
13 raw or dried material for resale; or

14 (ii) Traditional farming practices such as drying, shucking and bucking, storing,
15 trimming, and curing."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
