SECTION 1.

6 Code Section 2-23-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions7 regarding hemp farming, is amended by revising paragraph (10) as follows:

8 "(10)(A) 'Process' or 'processing,' except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (B) of
9 this paragraph, means converting an agricultural commodity into a legally marketable
10 form.

11 (B) This Such term does not include:

12 (i) merely Merely placing raw or dried material into another container or packaging

13 raw or dried material for resale; or

14 (ii) Traditional farming practices such as drying, shucking and bucking, storing,

15 <u>trimming, and curing</u>."
