## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 primaries and elections generally, so as to provide a definition; to prohibit certain activities
- 3 within close proximity to polling places; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to primaries and elections generally, is amended in Code Section 21-2-2, relating to definitions, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

"(3.1) 'Campaign material' means any newspaper, booklet, pamphlet, card, sign, paraphernalia, or any other written or printed matter referring to:

**SECTION 1.** 

12 (A) A candidate whose name appears on the ballot in a primary or election;

(B) A referendum which appears on the ballot in a primary or election; or

(C) A political party or body which has a nominee or nominees on the ballot in a

16 **SECTION 2.** 

- 17 Said chapter is further amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 21-2-414, relating
- 18 to restrictions on campaign activities and public opinion polling within the vicinity of a
- 19 polling place, cellular phone use prohibited, prohibition of candidates from entering certain
- 20 polling places, and penalty, as follows:
- 21 "(a) No person shall solicit votes in any manner or by any means or method, nor shall any
- 22 person distribute or display any campaign <del>literature, newspaper, booklet, pamphlet, card,</del>
- 23 sign, paraphernalia, or any other written or printed matter of any kind material, nor shall
- 24 any person solicit signatures for any petition or conduct any exit poll or public opinion poll
- with voters on any day in which ballots are being cast:

26 (1) Within 150 feet of the outer edge of any building within which a polling place is

- established;
- 28 (2) Within any polling place; or
- 29 (3) Within 25 feet of any voter standing in line to vote at any polling place.
- 30 These restrictions shall not apply to conduct occurring in private offices or areas which
- 31 cannot be seen or heard by such electors."

## 32 SECTION 3.

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
