A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 2 government general provisions, so as to provide for a minimum wage for state contractors
- 3 and state employees; to provide for definitions; to provide for an increase in the minimum
- 4 wage; to provide for annual minimum wage increases to match the rising cost of living; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state government
- 9 general provisions, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>50-1-10.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'public employer' means every department,
- board, bureau, commission, authority, or other agency of the State of Georgia.
- 13 (b) A public employer shall pay or cause to be paid under the terms of any contract with
- or in the direct employment of any employee by such public employer a minimum wage
- which shall not be less than \$10.10 per hour for each hour worked in the employment of
- such public employer or under any contract with such public employer. On January 1,
- 17 <u>2016</u>, and on January 1 of each successive year thereafter, the minimum wage shall be
- increased by the same percentage as the increase in the cost of living, if any.
- 19 (c) On September 30, 2015, and on September 30 of each successive year thereafter, the
- 20 Georgia Department of Labor shall measure the increase in the cost of living as being the
- 21 percentage increase as of the preceding July over the July level of the immediately
- 22 preceding year according to the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and
- 23 <u>Clerical Workers or its successor index as published by the United States Department of</u>
- 24 <u>Labor or its successor agency. Each adjusted minimum wage rate calculated shall be</u>
- 25 <u>published by the Georgia Department of Labor and take effect on the following January 1."</u>
