## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 5-6-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 judgments and rulings deemed directly appealable, procedure for review of judgments,
- 3 orders, or decisions not subject to direct appeal, scope of review, and hearings in criminal
- 4 cases involving a capital offense for which death penalty is sought, so as to limit the scope
- 5 of judgments or orders in child custody cases which are subject to direct appeal; to provide
- 6 for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Code Section 5-6-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to judgments and
- 11 rulings deemed directly appealable, procedure for review of judgments, orders, or decisions
- 12 not subject to direct appeal, scope of review, and hearings in criminal cases involving a
- capital offense for which death penalty is sought, is amended by revising paragraph (11) of
- 14 subsection (a) as follows:
- 15 "(11) All judgments or orders in child custody cases including, but not limited to,
- awarding or, refusing to change, or modifying child custody or holding or declining to
- hold persons in contempt of such child custody judgment or orders; and"
- 18 SECTION 2.
- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- without such approval.
- 21 SECTION 3.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
