## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia and the University
- 3 System of Georgia, so as to create the Student Advisory Council and the Faculty Advisory
- 4 Council; to provide for powers, duties, authorities, and functions; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 9 Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia and the University System of Georgia,
- 10 is amended by adding two new parts to read as follows:
