## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 mandatory education for children between ages six and 16, so as to change the ages of
- 3 mandatory education; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mandatory
- 7 education for children between ages six and 16, is amended by revising subsection (a) as
- 8 follows:
- 9 "(a) Mandatory attendance in a public school, private school, or home school program shall
- be required for children between their sixth fifth and sixteenth seventeenth birthdays. Such
- mandatory attendance shall not be required where the child is not eligible for enrollment
- 12 <u>under Code Section 20-2-150;</u> has successfully completed all requirements for a high
- school diploma, a general educational development (GED) diploma, a special diploma, or
- 14 a certificate of high school completion; is enrolled in an adult literacy program,
- postsecondary technical school, or adult vocational center; or provides a signed agreement
- between the student and the student's parent or guardian and from the student's principal
- or the superintendent of the student's school system which states that the student has
- enrolled in a certified general educational development program."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
