## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 tribes, bands, groups, and communities recognized by this state as legitimate American
- 3 Indian Tribes, so as to officially recognize the Yonah Band of Cherokees as an American
- 4 Indian tribe of Georgia; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tribes, bands, groups, and communities recognized by this state as legitimate American Indian Tribes, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:

- "(a) The State of Georgia officially recognizes as legitimate American Indian tribes of
   Georgia the following tribes, bands, groups, or communities:
- 12 (1) The Georgia Tribe of Eastern Cherokee
- 13 P.O. Box 1993
- Dahlonega, Georgia 30533;
- 15 (2) The Lower Muscogee Creek Tribe
- 16 Route 2, Box 370
- Whigham, Georgia 31797; and
- 18 (3) The Cherokee of Georgia Tribal Council
- 19 Saint George, Georgia 31646:; and
- 20 (4) The Yonah Band of Cherokees
- 21 <u>P.O. Box 704</u>
- 22 <u>Cleveland, Georgia 30525.</u> "

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
