A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 7 of Chapter 8 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
relating to employment security benefits, so as to increase the minimum and maximum
weekly benefit amounts; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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SECTION 1.

Article 7 of Chapter 8 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
employment security benefits, is amended by revising subsections (b) and (c) of Code
Section 34-8-193, relating determination of weekly benefit amount, as follows:

10 "(b) Weekly benefit amount entitlement as computed in this Code section shall be no less 11 than \$27.00 per week for benefit years beginning on or after July 1, 1983; provided, 12 however, that for benefit years beginning on or after July 1, 1987, when the weekly benefit amount, as computed, would be more than \$26.00 but less than \$37.00, the individual's 13 14 weekly benefit amount will be \$37.00, and no weekly benefit amount shall be established 15 for less than \$37.00; provided, further, that for benefit years beginning on or after July 1, 1997, when the weekly benefit amount, as computed, would be more than \$26.00 but less 16 than \$39.00, the individual's weekly benefit amount will be \$39.00, and no weekly benefit 17 amount shall be established for less than \$39.00; provided, further, that for benefit years 18 19 beginning on or after July 1, 2002, when the weekly benefit amount, as computed, would be more than \$26.00 but less than \$40.00, the individual's weekly benefit amount will be 20 21 \$40.00, and no weekly benefit amount shall be established for less than \$40.00; provided, 22 further, that for benefit years beginning on or after July 1, 2005, when the weekly benefit amount, as computed, would be more than \$26.00 but less than \$42.00, the individual's 23 24 weekly benefit amount will be \$42.00, and no weekly benefit amount shall be established 25 for less than \$42.00; provided, further, that for benefit years beginning on or after July 1, 2007, when the weekly benefit amount, as computed, would be more than \$26.00 but less 26

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| 27 | than \$44.00, the individual's weekly benefit amount will be \$44.00, and no weekly benefit |
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| 28 | amount shall be established for less than \$44.00; provided, further, that for benefit years |

| 32 | (c) Weekly benefit amount entitlement as computed in this Code section shall not exceed |
| 33 | these amounts for the applicable time period: |
| 34 | (1) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1990, but before July 1, 1994, the maximum |
| 35 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$185.00; |
| 36 | (2) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1994, but before July 1, 1995, the maximum |
| 37 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$195.00; |
| 38 | (3) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1995, but before July 1, 1996, the maximum |
| 39 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$205.00; |
| 40 | (4) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1996, but before July 1, 1997, the maximum |
| 41 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$215.00; |
| 42 | (5) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1997, but before July 1, 1998, the maximum |
| 43 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$224.00; |
| 44 | (6) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1998, but before July 1, 1999, the maximum |
| 45 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$244.00; |
| 46 | (7) For claims filed on or after July 1, 1999, but before July 1, 2000, the maximum |
| 47 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$264.00; |
| 48 | (8) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2000, but before July 1, 2001, the maximum |
| 49 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$274.00; |
| 50 | (9) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2001, but before July 1, 2002, the maximum |
| 51 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$284.00; |
| 52 | (10) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2002, but before July 1, 2003, the maximum |
| 53 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$295.00; |
| 54 | (11) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2003, but before July 1, 2005, the maximum |
| 55 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$300.00; |
| 56 | (12) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2005, but before July 1, 2006, the maximum |
| 57 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$310.00; |
| 58 | (13) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2006, but before July 1, 2008, the maximum |
| 59 | weekly benefit amount shall not exceed \$320.00; and |
| 60 | (14) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2008, the maximum weekly benefit amount shall |
| 61 | not exceed \$330.00 <u>; and</u> |
| 62 | (15) For claims filed on or after July 1, 2019, the maximum weekly benefit amount shall |
| 63 | not exceed \$400.00." |

SECTION 2.

65 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
