A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to labor and industrial relations, so as to allow employees to use
- 3 sick leave for the care of immediate family members; to provide for definitions; to provide
- 4 for conditions to take leave; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions relative to labor and industrial relations, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>34-1-8.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Employee' means any individual employed by an employer.
- 14 (2) 'Employer' means any person or entity that employs ten or more individuals and shall
- include the State of Georgia and its political subdivisions and instrumentalities.
- 16 (3) 'Immediate family member' means an employee's child, spouse, grandchild,
- grandparent, or parent or any dependents as shown in the employee's most recent tax
- 18 return.
- 19 (4) 'Sick leave' means time away from work by an employee for which the employee
- 20 receives compensation and is limited to sick time. 'Sick leave' shall not include paid
- 21 <u>short-term or long-term disability, catastrophic leave, or similar types of benefits.</u>
- 22 (b) An employer that provides sick leave shall allow an employee to use such sick leave
- 23 <u>for the care of an immediate family member; provided, however, that nothing in this Code</u>
- 24 section shall be construed to require an employer to offer sick leave of any kind or to
- 25 require an employer to allow an employee to use more than five days of earned sick leave
- for the care of an immediate family member.

- 27 (c) An employee shall not be entitled to use sick leave under this Code section until that
- 28 leave has been earned. Any employee who uses such sick leave shall comply with the
- 29 terms of the employer's employee sick leave policy."

30 **SECTION 2.**

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
