A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 42-1-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 restrictions on registered offenders residing, working, or loitering within certain distances
- 3 of child care facilities, churches, schools, or areas where minors congregate, so as to apply
- 4 loitering restrictions to individuals registered as sexual offenders in other states who are
- 5 visiting this state; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 42-1-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restrictions on
- 10 registered offenders residing, working, or loitering within certain distances of child care
- 11 facilities, churches, schools, or areas where minors congregate, is amended by revising
- 12 subsection (d) as follows:
- 13 "(d) Notwithstanding any ordinance or resolution adopted pursuant to Code Section
- 14 16-6-24 or subsection (d) of Code Section 16-11-36, it shall be unlawful for any individual
- or for any person who is or should be registered on another state's sexual offender registry
- to loiter, as prohibited by Code Section 16-11-36, at any child care facility, school, or area
- where minors congregate."

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
