A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 6 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Legislative Retirement System, so as to increase the retirement allowance; to
- 3 provide for related matters; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 6 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 8 Legislative Retirement System, is amended in Code Section 47-6-80, relating to eligibility
- 9 and application for a retirement allowance, early retirement, amount of retirement allowance,
- 10 compliance with federal tax laws, and increases in retirement allowance, by revising
- 11 subsections (a) and (d) as follows:
- 12 "(a) Upon the written application to the board, any member of the system who (1) has
- attained age 65 and has completed eight or more years of creditable service or (2) has
- attained age 62 and has completed eight or more years of membership service shall be
- retired by the board on a retirement allowance and shall thereupon become a beneficiary
- of the system, provided that he <u>or she</u> is no longer in the service of the state, whether as a

17 member of the General Assembly or otherwise. In lieu of eight years of service, a member

- may substitute four terms of office in the General Assembly."
- 19 "(d) Upon such retirement under subsection (a) of this Code section, the retired member
- shall receive a monthly service retirement allowance which shall be equal to \$28.00 \$50.00
- 21 multiplied by the number of years of the member's creditable service."

SECTION 2.

- 23 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2022, only if it is determined to have been
- 24 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 25 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- 26 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2022, as
- 27 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

28 SECTION 3.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
