## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to designate a Purple Heart Day; to amend Article 3 of
- 3 Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to other state
- 4 symbols, so as to provide that Georgia shall be a "Purple Heart State"; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 9 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "1-4-21.
- 11 (a) August 7 of every year is designated as 'Purple Heart Day.'
- 12 (b) The Governor may annually issue a proclamation designating August 7 as 'Purple
- Heart Day.' Public officials, schools, private organizations, and all residents of this state
- 14 are encouraged to commemorate Purple Heart Day and honor those wounded or killed
- while serving in any branch of the United States Armed Services."

SECTION 2.

- 17 Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to other
- state symbols, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 19 "<u>50-3-86.</u>
- 20 Georgia is designated as a 'Purple Heart State,' honoring our combat wounded veterans for
- 21 their service and sacrifice in allowing the United States of America to maintain its
- 22 sovereignty."
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
