A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To repeal a Resolution Act which declared certain United States Supreme Court decisions  
2 of 1954 and 1955 in school segregation cases and similar decisions by the Supreme Court  
3 to be null, void, and of no effect in this State, approved March 9, 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 642);  
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Resolution Act No. 130 (House Resolution No. 185), which declared the United States  
8 Supreme Court decisions of May 17, 1954, and May 31, 1955, in the school segregation  
9 cases, and all similar decisions by the Supreme Court, to be null, void, and of no effect in this  
10 State, approved March 9, 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 642), is hereby repealed.

12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
