## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To repeal a Resolution Act which declared certain United States Supreme Court decisions
- 2 of 1954 and 1955 in school segregation cases and similar decisions by the Supreme Court
- 3 to be null, void, and of no effect in this State, approved March 9, 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 642);
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Resolution Act No. 130 (House Resolution No. 185), which declared the United States
- 8 Supreme Court decisions of May 17, 1954, and May 31, 1955, in the school segregation
- 9 cases, and all similar decisions by the Supreme Court, to be null, void, and of no effect in this
- 10 State, approved March 9, 1956 (Ga. L. 1956, p. 642), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2.

12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
