**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT**

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 general provisions relative to game and fish, so as to provide protection for certain wildlife  
3 habitats; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 Chapter 1 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general  
7 provisions relative to game and fish, is amended by revising Code Section 27-1-30, relating  
8 to prohibitions on disturbing or destroying wildlife habitats, as follows:

9 "27-1-30.

10 Except as otherwise provided by law or regulation, it shall be unlawful to disturb, mutilate,  
11 or destroy the dens, holes, or homes of any wildlife; to blind wildlife with lights; or to use  
12 explosives, chemicals, electrical or mechanical devices, or smokers of any kind in order to  
13 drive such wildlife out of such habitats, ~~provided that this Code section shall not apply to~~  
14 ~~poisonous snakes."~~

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
