A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to medical assistance generally, so as to provide Medicaid coverage for pregnant women for a period of not less than 12 months; to provide for submission of a state plan amendment if necessary; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9	medical assistance generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
10	″ <u>49-4-159.</u>
11	(a) The department shall provide medical assistance under this article to pregnant women
12	eligible for such medical assistance for a period of not less than 12 months following the
13	date the woman gives birth or experiences an involuntary miscarriage.
14	(b) The department shall submit a Medicaid state plan amendment, if necessary to
15	implement the provisions of this Code section, to the United States Department of Health
16	and Human Services."

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SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
