A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 29 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 dispensing opticians, so as to exempt from licensure an employee of a licensed physician or
- 3 optometrist who is under the direct or real-time supervision of a licensed optician; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 29 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to dispensing
- 9 opticians, is amended in Code Section 43-29-18, relating to construction of chapter, by
- 10 revising subsection (f) as follows:
- 11 "(f) Nothing contained in this chapter shall be construed to require an employee of a
- licensed physician or a licensed optometrist to secure a license under this chapter or be
- otherwise subject to this chapter, so long as such employee is working exclusively for and
- under the direct supervision of such licensed physician or optometrist or the direct or
- 15 <u>real-time supervision of a licensed optician and does not hold himself or herself</u> out to the
- public generally as a dispensing optician."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
