A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 6A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to tuition grant assistance for University of North Georgia, so
- 3 as to authorize tuition grant assistance for certain students at Georgia Military College; to
- 4 provide for eligibility and procedures; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Subpart 6A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 9 Annotated, relating to tuition grant assistance for University of North Georgia, is amended
- 10 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>20-3-447.</u>
- 12 (a) In the event that the General Assembly appropriates funds in excess of the amount
- 13 necessary to fully fund all eligible students who apply for grants under this subpart at the
- 14 University of North Georgia, eligible students at Georgia Military College shall be allowed
- to apply for grants from the excess funds.
- 16 (b) Eligible students at Georgia Military College shall meet all conditions of eligibility
- 17 contained in Code Section 20-3-441 with the exceptions that, instead of being enrolled in
- or accepted for enrollment in the University of North Georgia, such eligible student shall
- be enrolled in or accepted for enrollment in Georgia Military College for a minimum of 12
- 20 <u>academic hours, and instead of being enrolled in or planning to enroll in the Army Reserve</u>
- 21 Officers' Training Corps at the University of North Georgia, such eligible student shall be
- 22 <u>enrolled in or planning to enroll in the Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps program at</u>
- 23 <u>Georgia Military College.</u>
- 24 (c) Such grants to eligible students at Georgia Military College shall be in the amount of
- 25 \$1,500.00 per academic semester.

26 (d) Each eligible student wishing to receive the grant provided for in this Code section 27 shall submit to Georgia Military College an application for the grant payment at the time 28 and in accordance with procedures prescribed by the authority. The authority is authorized 29 to define such terms and prescribe such rules, regulations, and procedures as may be 30 reasonable and necessary to carry out the purposes of this Code section. The authority 31 shall not approve payment of any grant until it has received from an appropriate officer of 32 Georgia Military College a certification that the student applying for the grant is an eligible student. Upon timely receipt of such certification, in proper form, the authority is 33 34 authorized to pay the grant to Georgia Military College on behalf of and to the credit of the 35 student. In the event a student on whose behalf a grant is paid does not enroll as a full-time student for the school term for which the grant is paid, Georgia Military College shall make 36 37 a refund to the authority in accordance with regulations of the authority. 38 (e) In the event that the General Assembly does not appropriate funds in excess of that 39 required to fulfill the grants for eligible students at the University of North Georgia, no 40 grants under this Code section shall be available for eligible students at Georgia Military 41 College. 42 (f) Georgia Military College shall be subject to examination by the state auditor for the 43 sole purpose of determining whether the school has properly certified eligibility and 44 enrollment of students and credited grants paid on behalf of such students. However, 45 nothing in this Code section shall be construed to interfere with the authority of the school 46 to determine admissibility of students or to control its own curriculum, philosophy, 47 purpose, or administration. In the event it is determined that the school knowingly or 48 through error certified an ineligible student to be eligible for a grant under this Code 49 section, the amount of the grant paid to the school pursuant to such certification shall be 50 refunded by the school to the authority."

52 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
