## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding the Georgia Lottery for Education Act, so as to allow
- 3 a winner of a lottery prize to remain anonymous under certain conditions; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 general provisions regarding the Georgia Lottery for Education Act, is amended by adding
- 10 a new subsection to Code Section 50-27-25, relating to confidentiality of information,
- 11 investigations, supervision and inspections, reports of suspected violations, and assistance
- 12 in investigation of violations, to read as follows:
- 13 "(d) The corporation shall keep all information regarding the winner of awards of
- 14 \$250,000.00 or greater confidential upon the prize winner making a written request that his
- or her information be kept confidential."

SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
